Rules for Campaigning

- 1. All campaign items must be made at ALA IGS. No photo's, photocopied items or "passouts" will be allowed. No Computer Created Material is allowed.
- 2. Social Media Campaigning is strictly prohibited.
- 3. No campaign material shall be posted or distributed prior to filing a petition.
- 4. No campaign material shall be posted on campus or in the dining hall. Masking tape only is to be used for posting campaign signs. No signs are to be taped to the floors.
- 5. No glitter or glitter glue may be used on campaign signs or posters.
- 6. No campaigning during Elections within 10 feet of the Polling Place.
- 7. Activities on Party Convention Night will be confined to the Ballroom assigned to each Party.
- 8. At the close of the State Conventions, the citizens shall return to their dorms immediately.
- 9. County Candidates will be presented in their respective counties by the County Chairman of each Party.
- 10. Posted campaign materials must be removed by the candidates following the election proclamations.
- 11. You may not campaign or announce your declaration to run for office prior to filing a petition.
- 12. You may not announce the office you are running for when asking a question of a speaker.

Campaign rules will be monitored by a committee of citizens.

AMERICAN LEGION AUXILIARY GIRLS NATION

American Legion Auxiliary Girls Nation is a continuation of the government learning process started at American Legion Auxiliary Illini Girls State. Two citizens will be selected/elected from American Legion Auxiliary Illini Girls State to represent Illinois as U.S. Senators. The process starts with the city counselors. You will be interviewed and asked for an idea of a federal bill you would like to see introduced to become law. If you are chosen as the candidate from your city, you will then be interviewed by the staff advisors and counselors that make up your county at American Legion Auxiliary Illini Girls State. At this point, your bill must be in writing. Don't worry, your counselor and staff advisor will have a sample bill so it can be written in the proper format. It does not have to be typed or perfectly written. The important part will be your idea and how you see your idea being realized. The four county candidates will participate in county "whistle stops". You will present your bill to each ALA Illini Girls State county and then be asked questions by citizens that pertain to your bill. The citizens of American Legion Auxiliary Illini Girls State will then elect two U.S. Senators to represent them.

No matter what office your hold at ALA IGS, you CAN run for US Senator. This is the only time you can hold an office AND run for an office. You do not have to forfeit the office you already have.

If elected, you MUST be able to attend for the full week. This is held at the William F. Bolger Center in Potomac MD, just outside of Washington, DC. The dates for this year are July 20-27, 2024. DO NOT LET COST CONCERN YOU. The National American Legion Auxiliary pays for the senator's round trip flight from the airport closest to her home. Once there, the only expenses will be souvenirs.

ALA Girls Nation gives you opportunities that you may not otherwise get to experience. You could visit Arlington National Cemetery, the Pentagon, and many different memorials throughout Washington honoring our leaders and heroes. You could possibly even visit the White House and meet the President. On Thursday, you will spend the day on Capitol Hill meeting with your representatives and senators. These appointments are made for you by the ALA Girls Nation staff.

Back at the William F. Bolger Center, you will have the opportunity to meet in committees to determine which of the bills introduced by each state will go to the full ALA Girls Nation Senate floor. Throughout the week you will have senate sessions to debate and vote on bills and resolutions. You will also have party conventions to elect your leaders and your candidates for President and Vice President of the Senate.

American Legion Auxiliary Girls Nation is an experience of a lifetime!! So, COME WITH AN IDEA FOR A FEDERAL BILL THAT YOU WOULD LIKE TO SEE BECOME LAW! Go through the process and take a chance. It could be an experience that will change your life.

POLICY STATEMENT

American Legion Auxiliary Illini Girls State is sponsored by the American Legion Auxiliary. The American Legion Auxiliary is an organization based on the principles for God and Country.

American Legion Auxiliary Illini Girls State reserves the right to accept or reject any application to the American Legion Auxiliary Illini Girls State.

After the American Legion Auxiliary Illini Girls State is in progress, the right is reserved for the Director to dismiss any citizen for violation of the rules of the American Legion Auxiliary Illini Girls State or other good cause, as determined by the Director regardless of sponsorship.

Any citizen of the American Legion Auxiliary Illini Girls State found to be using, or in possession of intoxicants, illegal drugs, firearms, other weapons or explosives, gambling, destroying property, or leaving the IGS campus area without the permission of the Director or her Staff Advisor may be subject to immediate dismissal without refund and barred from further participation in the program.

Sponsoring American Legion Auxiliary Units, contributing organizations, parents and school officials will be notified of any delegate's failure to complete the session and the request will be made that American Legion Auxiliary Illini Girls State be stricken from the delegate's academic records.

A delegate failing to complete the American Legion Auxiliary Illini Girls State session without just cause, barring illness or death in the family, may be held responsible for reimbursing the delegate fee to their sponsor.

HEALTH and MEDICAL

During American Legion Auxiliary Illini Girls State first aid and/or medical attention, if required, will be available. Every care will be taken to avoid accidents and prevent illness, but the American Legion Auxiliary Illini Girls State will not be responsible for either injuries or sickness should they occur.

ACCOMODATIONS POLICY

American Legion Auxiliary Illini Girls State welcomes participants with all levels of ability. If accommodations are required to participate, Department Headquarters and the American Legion Auxiliary Illini Girls State Director must be informed in advance. Requests will be reviewed and a determination will be made regarding if the accommodations can be provided within the structure of the program. If an applicant requires a personal care aide, that student's sponsoring Unit or contributing organization must furnish a full time female aide, over 21 years of age, to assist the student. All expenses for the aide, including transportation, meals and lodging will be assumed by the sponsoring unit

or contributing organization. Proof of legal age of the aide is required. This is to be furnished to the American Legion Auxiliary Illini Girls State Director with the student's application. Also, the American Legion Auxiliary Illini Girls State must be assured that proper insurance is provided for the student and her aide, and any additional premiums will be assumed by the sponsoring Unit, contributing organization and parent or guardian of the student.

The American Legion Auxiliary Illini Girls State is an educational exercise in which the majority of the base skills are transmitted to the delegates via verbal and published communications.

The American Legion Auxiliary Illini Girls State program will make every effort to afford qualified individual delegates an opportunity to participate regardless of ability, but at no cost to the American Legion Auxiliary Illini Girls State.

HEARING/VISION ACCOMODATIONS POLICY

The following policies will be applied to Hearing and/or Vision Impaired applicants:

- 1. The applicant must be accompanied, so as to provide her personal safety at all times, by a qualified person (personal aide) or signing person (an interpreter) of the same sex and of legal age that is capable of voice communication as well as sign language.
- 2. The aide or interpreter must accompany the student to all the program functions and must adhere to all delegate rules.
- 3. The aide or interpreter will be subject to the same fees as a delegate but will not be allowed to participate in the actual program without the express prior permission of the American Legion Auxiliary Illini Girls State Director.
- 4. The American Legion Auxiliary Illini Girls State will not be responsible to the aide or interpreter in any way, for any remuneration for her efforts on behalf of the hearing and/or vision impaired delegate.
- 5. If there are varying degrees of vision impairment, or a seeing eye dog involved, that may be subject to variations of the above rules, they will be considered on an individual basis by the Director of the American Legion Auxiliary Illini Girls State.
- 6. These restrictions are in addition to the American Legion Auxiliary Illini Girls State Accommodations Policy.

All arrangements for any hearing impaired and/or vision impaired delegate must be submitted in writing and approved by the American Legion Auxiliary Illini Girls State Director, before the individual's acceptance as a delegate to the American Legion Auxiliary Illini Girls State program.

Participants who do not already have group accident/sickness medical insurance coverage are insured under a group policy provided by the American Legion Auxiliary. This policy is EXCESS COVERAGE to any other valid and collectible group insurance plan. *This exclusion does not apply to individual accident and sickness policies*. Should an unforeseen need arise for this insurance program, more detailed information will be sent directly to you at that time.
